Convenient. Supportive. Smart.

LIFE PACE, a Program of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly, is a comprehensive, coordinated senior healthcare program that uses a team approach to provide medical, social, nutritional, personal and home care services. LIFE PACE allows individuals in need of skilled care to remain in their homes or community setting while receiving the care they need. A LIFE PACE individualized care plan may include:

## MEDICAL

(No Co-Pays/Out-of-Pocket Expenses)

- Medication Coverage
- Primary and Specialty Care Visits
- Mental and Behavioral Health
- 24/7 On-call Medical Personnel Availability

## SKILLED THERAPY

- Physical Therapy
- Occupational Therapy
- Speech Therapy

## COMMUNITY & HOME CARE SERVICES

- Adult Day Health Center
- Respite Care
- Personal Care (Bathing, Dressing, Grooming)
- Light Housekeeping and Laundry

## ADDITIONAL SERVICES

(No Co-Pays/Out-of-Pocket Expenses)

- Dietary Plans, Counseling and Education
- Durable Medical Equipment
- Medical and Personal Care Supplies
- Covered Hospital Admission/Stays
- Necessary Ambulance Transport

# LIFE PACE

Provides Transportation

One of the many benefits of LIFE PACE is that it provides free transportation to and from the Adult Day Health Centers, the LIFE PACE Center and medically necessary appointments in the community for the frequency approved by the Interdisciplinary Team.

## WHO CAN JOIN LIFE PACE?

You can join LIFE PACE if:

- You are age 55 or older;
- You live in the LIFE PACE service area;
- You meet a certain level of care determined from an assessment completed by a registered nurse; and
- Receiving PACE services would allow you to live safely in the community

## LIFE PACE ACCEPTS:

- SoonerCare (Oklahoma Medicaid)
- Medicare
- Private Pay

LIFE PACE does not discriminate in the delivery of PACE services based on race, ethnicity, national origin, religion, sex, sexual orientation, age, mental or physical disabilities, or source of payment.

Participants may be fully liable for the cost of services obtained without the authorization of the Interdisciplinary Team (except for any emergency situations).
